This is a guide for Android in general and about special functions of the ALLNET displays.


The display is a certified Google device.

Connect the tablet to the power supply. The tablet starts automatically.

Switching off the Touch Power Button in the front

You can disable the Power Touch button in the software. To do this, please go to the settings and select General Settings. The item "Touch button enable" deactivates or activates the power button in the front.

This function is essential when installed in a wall, otherwise the tablet can only be switched on/off via the power. The physical switch on the back is always active.




Automatic launch of an application

Unfortunately, this function is not available in the certified version. You have to help yourself with an app from the Playstore. E.g. AutoStart.


Split screen or split screen

To display two apps side by side at the same time, the apps must have been open for the first time. Then click on the square and on the icon at the top center. Click Share Links.

Now select the second app that you want to share on the screen.



Now the division ratio can still be changed.






Please note:


There please go to the item "Other security settings" and click on Screen fixation.






As an option, you can also install a security that locks the tablet when the app is closed.

To activate the screen lock, click on the square in the navigation bar, where you will find the most recently opened APPs. Click on the middle icon at the top of the app to use.






This screen fixation is no longer active after a restart and the procedure for fixing must be performed again.

Select Network&Internet, then click More




Ethernet is automatically activated as soon as a network cable is connected to a network connection. The Ethernet connection is preferred over a WLAN connection.


Setup W-LAN

Open the Settings app


Select "Wireless & Network", then click on Wi-Fi and activate the switch



Select the desired Wi-Fi network and enter the password if necessary. After a successful connection, the tablet will automatically connect to the network if it is within range.





You can set up a static network connection under IP Setting. By clicking on "static" you can set up the IP address, gateway and DNS server.





Under "System", select "Language & Input", then click on Language and select the desired language






You can activate the language by dragging the language up on the right edge.







Open the "Settings" app and select "System".

Select the "Date and Time" menu item from the "System" menu item.




You can either obtain the appropriate time zone automatically via the network or change it manually via the "Select time zone" item.






Screen Lock Settings

Select the "Sounds" menu item from the "Device" menu item. Here you can adjust the volume for media playback, alarms, and notifications.




Display settings

In addition to the brightness, you can also change the background or choose a screensaver.






Hide navigation bar/status bar

Select Display, then turn off Show NavigationBar/ or Phone StatusBar.





You can also operate the tablet with a mouse and keyboard. The left button is the "Mouse click", the right mouse button is the "Back" button

Settings "Automatically turn off the display"


Open the Settings app

Select "Display", then click on Advanced/Hibernation, now you can set the display's power off time. By activating the "Never" menu item, the screen remains active until the tablet is switched off.





Connection to the Google Play Store

Open the Play Store app and sign in with your Google account details to install the apps you want. If you don't have an account yet, you can create a new account directly from the app. If you have a problem with the launch of the Playstore, a component (Google SystemWebview.apk) of the Google Framework is deprecated and needs to be updated. To do this, the Chrome browser must be deactivated under Settings/Apps so that the SystemWebview.apk is visible. The tablet should update it automatically after some time, so it should be switched on and left on the Internet connection. This app can also be downloaded from external download websites such as APK Mirror. Please note that downloading external pages can be risky. We assume no liability for this!



Quit the app

Click the rectangular icon in the bottom navigation bar. You will then be shown all active apps, which you can then close if you wish.



Split-screen function:

To display two apps at the same time, there is this function.


Click the rectangular icon in the bottom navigation bar. You will then see all active apps. Click on the top logo in the middle of the app you want to use. A menu will open. Click on split screen and select the second app by clicking. These must be opened beforehand so that they can be selected.



Under Settings you will find the item "Screenshot". When clicked, a settings window opens.








Display Rotation

The display can be used horizontally and vertically. To do this, please go to the Display/Screen Rotation settings.




In the pop-up, select the number of degrees of rotation. The tablet will now restart in the set mode.



MDM Mobile Device Management:

The Google certified displays can be controlled with MDM software. To do this, you have to tap on a free space in the wizard 6 times in a row. The camera will open to scan the MDM code. This can also be typed in manually if the entry is incorrect.

A QR code via camera can also be captured. To help, the camera can be rotated and rotated here. This can be done under Settings/Connected Devices.




Update Firmware:

To update the firmware to Linux or an AOSP version, the tablet must be connected to the PC with a USB cable USB Type-A to Type-A connector. Before connecting it, please install the Rockchip drivers via the Rockchip DriverAssistant tool.

Note: Please check that no other ADB drivers are installed on the system. This can lead to errors in the detection of the tablet.

Under Settings/System, the first thing to do is to turn off the Turn on USB Host switch.



To flash the firmware, you need the AndroidTool_Release v5.1.1. Please write to our support to receive the firmware and the download link, support@allnet.de.

Here are the individual steps:

1. Install the "Release_DriverAssitant" driver.
2. Android-Tool start
3. Connect the USB port to the PC and tablet and connect the power adapter
4. You will now see an ADB device in the Android tool
5. Press the Firmware button under the "Upgrade Firmware" tab and select the Linux/Android image
6. Then press the "Switch" button
7. The tablet should now turn off the screen and there should be a loader device in the Android tool, takes about 30sec. If that doesn't work, there is a small hole next to the power connection on the tablet. There, with a bent paper clip, feel the switch behind it and at the same time give power. Press and hold the switch for about 3 seconds.
8. Then press the "EraseFlash" button, only necessary in case of errors or when changing systems
9. When the process is finished, you can click on the "Upgrade" button and the image will flash the Linux/Android to the system.
10. The device will automatically restart after the update process.

Update via USB with OTA Image:

An OTA image has the property of not deleting USER data, like a mobile phone. This image can be transferred via a server or installed via a USB stick.

Please save the firmware zip file under the name update.zip in the main directory of a USB stick. Start the tablet with an inserted USB stick (USB3.0 port). The tablet should update automatically. If that doesn't happen, go to Settings/System/systemupdates and install it manually.

!! Attention!!! The Google license expires if the firmware is deleted, replaced or changed if the OTA update offered by ALLNET is not used. This is especially true for a reinstallation of Linux on Android. In this case, there is also no entitlement to warranty or replacement.
